Refuge in the Lord

Psalms 19:1, 7 & 8

**The heavens declare the glory of God,
And the sky above proclaims his handiwork.
. . .The law of the Lord is perfect, reviving

It is no wonder David felt so fascinated by the trace of the sun in the firmament! To David, each new sunrise exemplified God’s character. Each new sunset further revealed God’s supremacy. Every morning, when David turned his head toward the far east, he was able to see God’s hand clearly in the blissful display of gentle beauty brought by sunrise.

When light, shining down upon humanity in doses of pink and golden blessings, touched David’s eyes, God’s character became luminous and clear to him: God was a God of mercy and justice to all.
