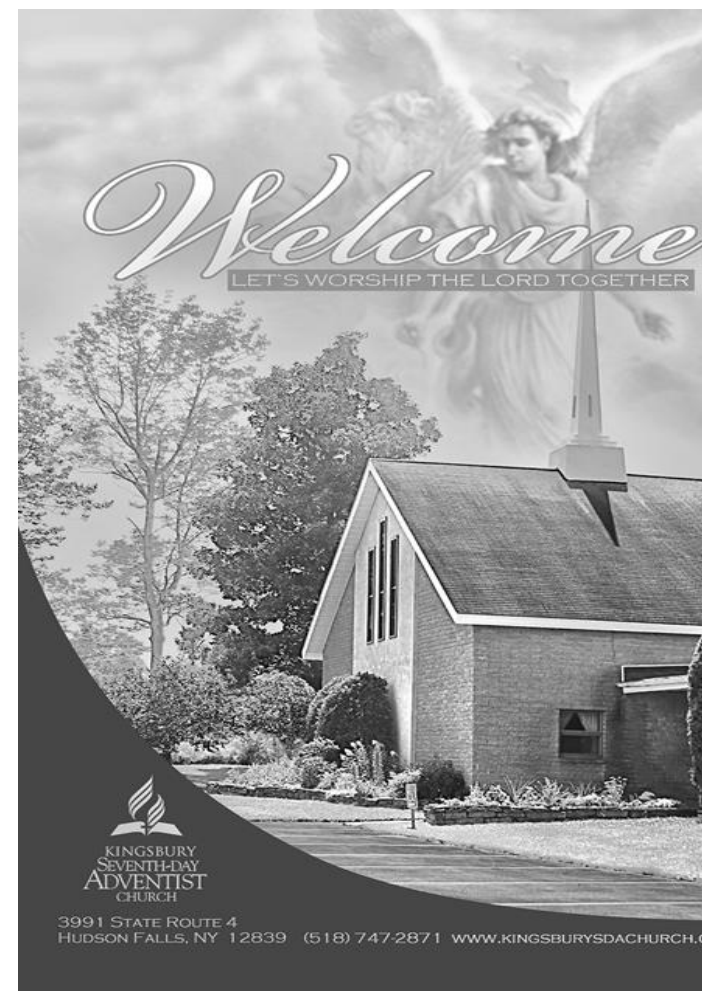

Sabbath Blessings

Refuge in the Lord

Psalms 25: 10

**All the paths of the Lord are steadfast love and faithfulness, for those who keep his covenant and his testimonies.
Verse 14: The friendship of the Lord is for those who fear him, and he makes known to them his covenant.**

In this psalm David recounts various adversities. David describes our own lives too as he recounts these trials. What does he do with these difficulties? What is his solution? Notice that he does not apply a different answer to each adversity. He turns to one source of healing for all of these diverse pains. “To you, O Lord, I lift up my soul.” I take refuge in you” (vs. 1 & 20) He does not address adversity with a prayer for better circumstances . He casts himself on God. We find internal calm by looking to God.
