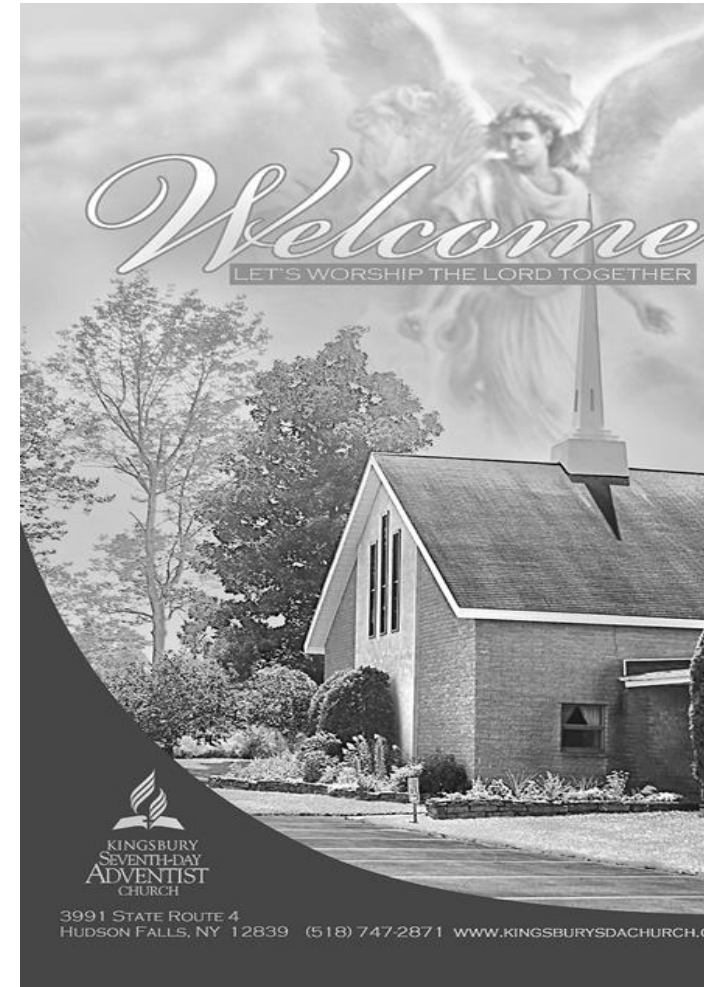

Refuge in the Lord

Psalms 71: 8 & 9

My mouth is filled with your praise,
and with your glory all the day. Do not
caste me off in the time of my old age;
forsake me not when my strength is spent.

This is the prayer of a saint in winter, who in his old age realizes that life is mostly over for him. David prays, “So even to old age and gray hairs, O God, do not forsake me.” Vs. 18. Pain is meant to draw our hearts up to God: “From the depths of the earth *you will bring me up again.*” Vs.20 Adversity is intended to heighten our hope in God. We are brought to remember that God is all we have and that He is enough.
