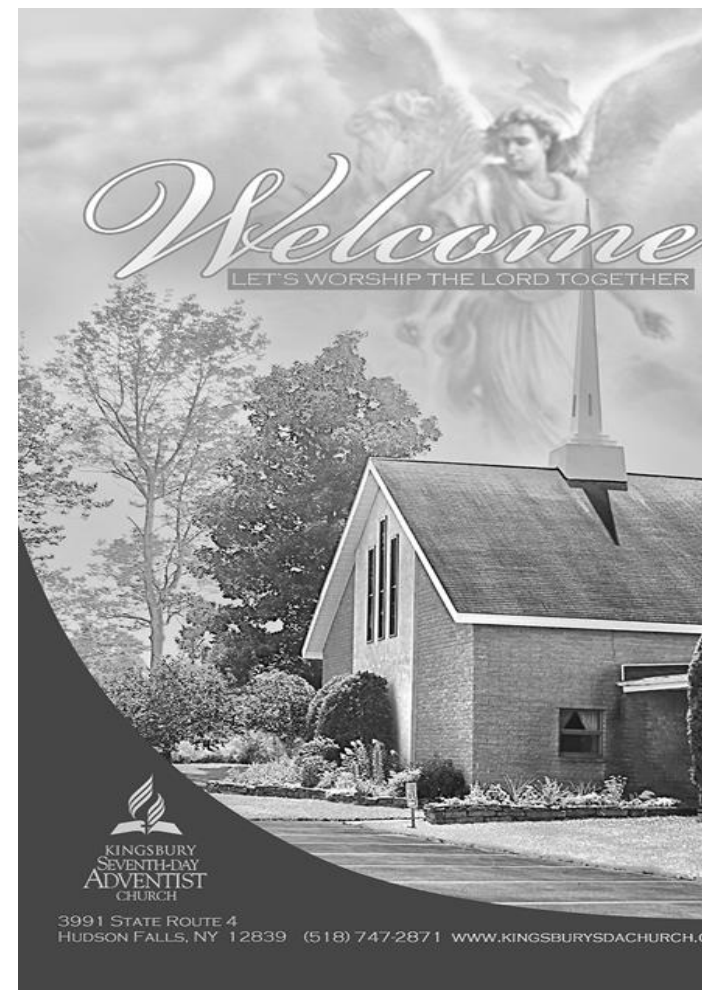

### *Refuge in the Lord*

**Psalms 84 :1,2, 10**

**How lovely is your dwelling place,  
O Lord of hosts!**

**My soul longs, yes, faints for the courts of  
the Lord; my heart and flesh sing for  
joy to the living God.**

**For a day in your courts is better than a  
thousand elsewhere. I would rather  
be a doorkeeper in the house of my God  
than dwell in the tents of wickedness.**

Seasoned Christians know to be true that pain and trials are often our deepest sources of spiritual nourishment and growth. The Psalmist cries out, seeking to dwell with God, for the presence of God is our true strength. That's why texts like Verse 11 are in the Bible – to recalibrate our hearts, “. . .the Lord bestows favor and honor. No good thing does He withhold from those who walk uprightly.” God is with you, lavishing –  
*“no good thing does he withhold.”*
