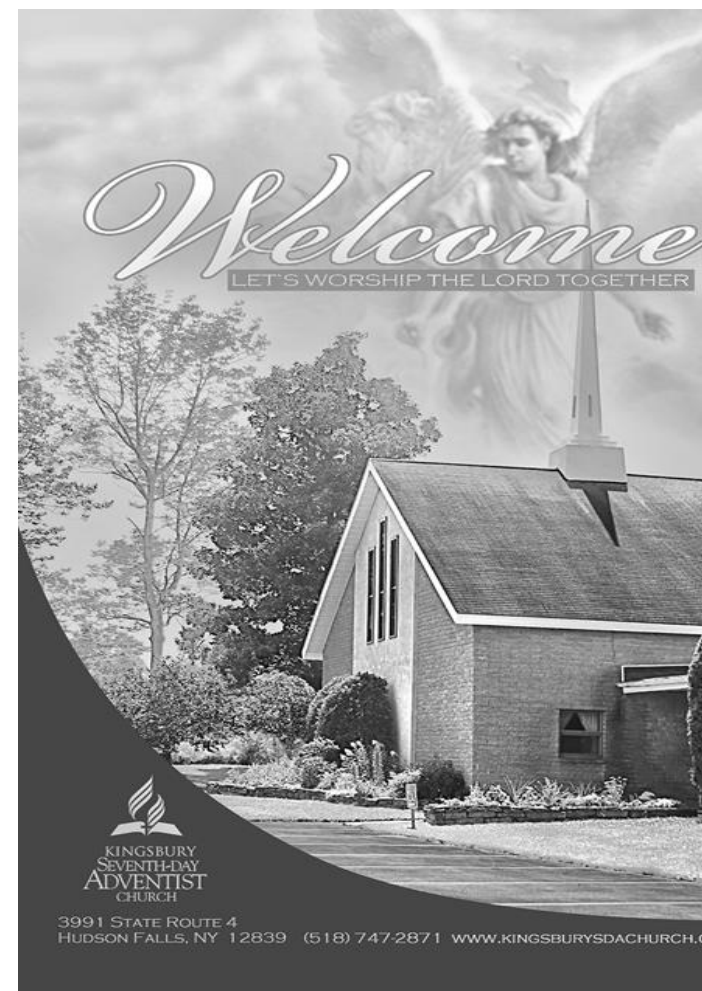

Refuge in the Lord

[When we come to the God of the Bible](#)
Psalms 107: 1

O give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever.
The point of Psalms 107 is captured in its final verse: **“Whoever is wise, let him attend to these things, let them consider the steadfast love of the Lord.”**

The entire psalm is a recitation of concrete examples of the steadfast love of the Lord- to those wandering in barren places (v. 4-9) to those sitting in darkness (v 10-16), to those suffering for their own sinful folly (v 17-22), and to those caught in a storm (v 23-32). The psalmist himself in verses 33-42 helps us to understand how the steadfast love of the Lord operates.
Ponder how God delights to work.
