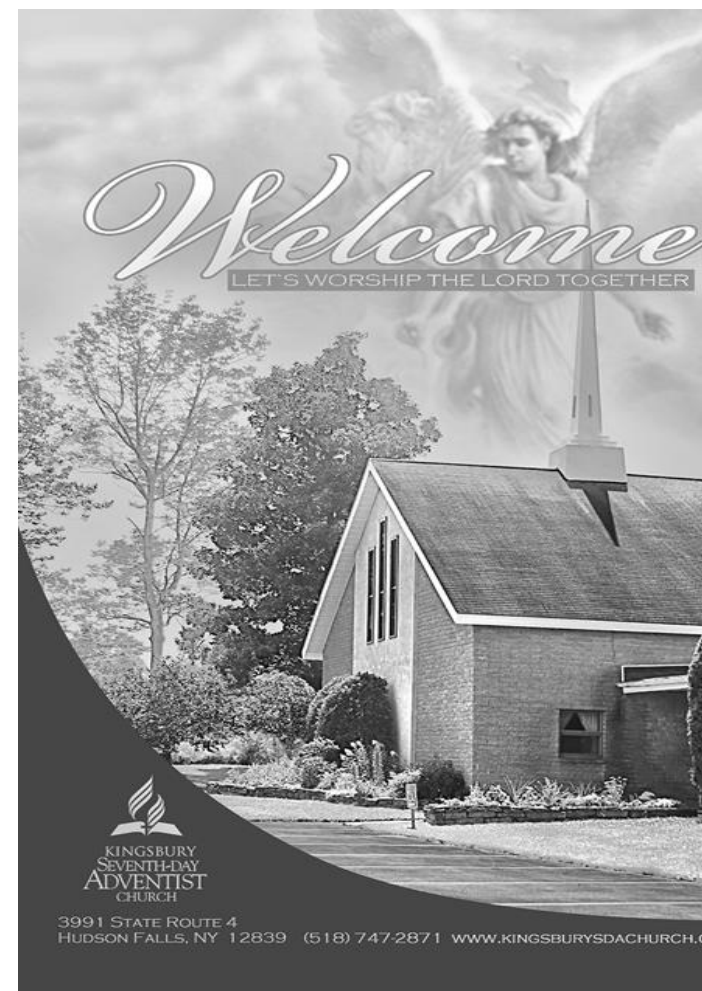

Refuge in the Lord

[When we come to the God of the Bible](#)

Psalms 118:1, 4, 5&6

Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for he is good.

.... . Let those who fear the Lord say,
"His steadfast love endures forever."

Out of my distress I called on the Lord;
and the Lord answered me and set me free,
The Lord is on my side, I will not fear.
What can man do to me?

Not only has God rescued the psalmist out of deadly peril, he also has worked a remarkable reversal so that such peril has been transformed into triumph; the valley has become the mountaintop. This is what the psalmist means when he declares, "Glad songs of salvation are in the tents of the righteous" (verse 15).
