

Psalms 131: 1- 3

O Lord, my heart is not lifted up;
my eyes are not raised too high;

I do not occupy myself with things too great and too marvelous for me.

But I have calmed and quieted my soul,
like a weaned child with its mother

O Israel, hope in the Lord from this time forth and forevermore.

Blessed smallness! The safety of humility! This is true security. The Bible is replete with assurances that it is those who embrace this healthy quietness of soul to whom God draws near. This posture communicates to the Lord that one is trusting in him, not in one's own plans or cleverness or ambitions. This psalm concludes with an attitude to "hope in the Lord."
